

Five in a line

What you need:

- Counters
- Dice (1 to 6)
- Decimal grid

- Take turns to choose a number from the grid and place a counter on it.
- Throw the dice three times, and write the dice numbers as a 2-place decimal number.
- For example, if you throw a 3, then a 2, then a 6, write 3.26.
- Write down your grid number and dice number. Add them and read out the total.
- Check with your group members whether your answer is correct. If correct, leave your counter on the grid. If not, remove it.
- Who is the first to place five counters in a straight line?
