

Time - Schedules

You are the controller of a television channel for the day. Choose from the programmes below to create the schedule for next week's television, from Monday to Friday. Remember that there are some rules you need to follow.

- Programmes begin at 16:00 and finish at 17:59 so you have a time slot of 1 hour and 59 minutes each day.
- Each day's schedule must include one animal programme, one news programme, one competition and one sports programme.
- A programme cannot be on twice in one week.
- Leave one minute between each programme for adverts.
- A news programme is never on last, but on a Friday it must be on after 17.30.
- An animal programme is never on first.

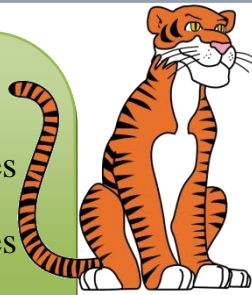
