

Wallpapering

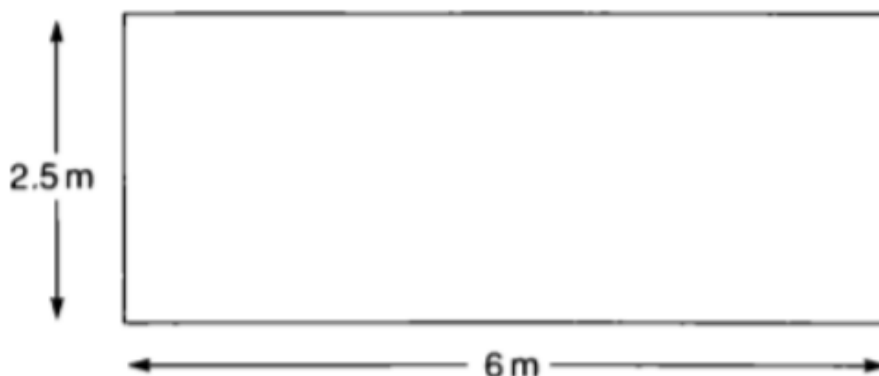
Wallpaper is sold in rolls with a standard length of 10 m and a standard width of 52 cm.

1. How many complete lengths can you cut from a roll if the wall you are preparing is 2m high?
 - b) In practice a wallpaper hanger cuts **an extra 10 cm** and then trims the right length when s/he hangs the wall paper on the wall.
Also, the wallpaper must be a full length from top to bottom.
Does this change your previous answer?

2. Steps to take before calculating how much wall paper do you need to cover a wall/a whole room.
 - Measure width and height of wall/s
 - Subtract any doors, windows or any other openings.
 - Calculate extra trimmings.

- a) Use the information in 1b, how much wall paper do you need to cover this wall?
