

## FLYING WITH PAPER PLANES

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1. Make 4 different paper planes. There are different ideas online. We chose to do 4 planes of different colours and different sizes, but you can get as creative as you wish. We also suggest you use used/recycled paper.
2. You can also get other family members involved. For example, everybody can make his/her paper plane.
3. Once you are ready, stand on a common point and throw your paper plane one after the other.
4. We suggest you measure the distance using tiles. But you can use other measuring tools to calculate distance.
5. Complete the table.
6. Compare the distances travelled by the four different planes.
7. Whose plane travelled furthest?
