

## Bingo Time (1 to 6/1 to 10/1 to 20 or more)

### Resources

- Reused paper
- Marker
- Bottle caps

1. Distribute the bingo cards to the players.
2. Play a simple version of Bingo by calling out numbers 1 to 10 randomly.
3. Have the players use plastic bottle caps to cover the corresponding numbers on their cards.
4. The first player to cover all the numbers in a row / column shouts 'Bingo' and is the winner.
5. To prolong the game and get more winners you can have additional games, like being the first to cover the entire first row, being the first to cover the entire second column and so on.



### Extension and Differentiation

- Play the game with less / more numbers.
- Players can play in small groups and take it in turns to call out the numbers.
- An adult can call out an addition or subtraction number sentence and the child will cover the answer.

# How many bottle caps?

## Resources

- Reused paper
- Marker
- Bottle caps
- Dice

1. Write the numbers below on a reused paper or use number cards.
2. Put 5 bottle caps on each number below.
3. Roll the dice.
4. Take a bottle cap from that number or say two numbers which add up to your dice-number and take a bottle cap from each number.
5. Go on until you cannot take any bottle caps.
6. How many bottle caps have you won?
7. Try to get more bottle caps next time.

Mark rolled 4. He worked out that  $3 + 1$  make 4. So he took a counter from 1 and from 3.
