

Number – Toilet Paper Rolls

1. Child may colour/paint toilet paper rolls.
2. Write a different number on each toilet paper.
3. Scatter the toilet paper rolls and invite your child to order them on top of each other, next to each other etc.
4. Whilst ordering them speak about what number comes before and / or after.

Extension and Differentiation

- Increase the number of toilet paper rolls if your child can be challenged to order numbers 1 to 20 or more.
- Order backwards as well.
- Sort the numbered paper rolls into groups Ex. Less / more than 10, odd / even etc.
- Ask your child to choose those toilet paper rolls that have multiples of 2 on them and together count in twos forwards and backwards.
