


Kitchen Facts!

<p>755 gr is more than 1 kg. <i>1 kg is 1000 grams so 755 grams is always less than 1 kg.</i></p>	<p>4 packets for €1.60 is the same value per packet as 3 for €1.20. <i>In each case the packets are 40c each.</i></p>
<p>Kitchen cupboards open clockwise. <i>Cupboards doors open both clockwise and anticlockwise while some are also pull ups.</i></p>	<p>You get more oranges than apples in a 1 kg net. <i>The weight of an orange or an apple depends on the size of fruit. Some apples are bigger and heavier than oranges and some oranges are bigger and heavier than apples.</i></p>
<p>The freezer temperature is less than 0° C (zero degrees Celsius). <i>0° C is freezing point.</i></p>	<p>You save more money in a 20% OFF of any price than in a 15% OFF of any price. <i>20% of €100 is €20 and 15% of €100 is €15. In this case 20% off is more than 15% off. However, 20% of €50 is €10 and 15% of €200 is €30. So, in this case 15% off is more because the price of the item is more expensive.</i></p>
<p>100 gr of dried rice weighs more when cooked. <i>Rice doubles in weight and volume when cooked.</i></p>	<p>All products come in different sizes. Buying the bigger one saves money. <i>In most items the larger version is less than double the price however this is not the rule.</i></p>
<p>200 ml of oil is heavier than 200 ml of water.</p>	<p>Jars and bottle caps open anticlockwise and close clockwise.</p>

<p><i>Oil is lighter than water. 200ml of water weighs around 200 grams while 200 ml of oil weighs around 185 grams.</i></p>	<p><i>All common items with a screw type fastener (caps, screws, bolts, jars, water hoses, etc.) screw to the right to tighten and to the left to loosen. Thus, the saying, "Righty tightly, lefty loosely"</i></p>
<p>1 L of water takes longer to boil than $\frac{1}{2}$ L of water.</p>	<p>Boiled rice takes longer to cook than boiled pasta.</p> <p><i>This may be true however today you can find dried rice in special packaging that cooks in less than 10 mins.</i></p>
<p>It takes me 45 minutes to bake a cake from the time I switch on the oven till I switch it off.</p> <p>It takes me double the time to bake two of the same cake.</p> <p><i>An oven needs time to heat so it takes a normal oven around 15 mins to heat up and start baking. If a second cake is going to be baked the oven is already hot and it takes less time to bake.</i></p>	<p>There are 4 members in my family. We share a packet of $\frac{1}{2}$ kg of pasta equally amongst us. This means each member gets $\frac{1}{4}$ of a kg.</p> <p><i>If 4 members share $\frac{1}{2}$ kg (500 grams) of pasta equally they each get $\frac{1}{8}$ kg (125grams).</i></p>
